

# Stat 328 Data Downloading Instructions

Vardeman will save data on the Stat 328 Web pages so that the following instructions will allow you to get the data and read them into a JMP 4.0 or JMP-IN 3.2.6 data table.

## ***EITHER***

**Step 0** Go to the Web page for the data set, right click on its link and use "Save Link as" to save the .txt file to your machine. In what follows we'll call the file "data.txt" .

## ***OR***

**Step 1** Go to the Web page for the data set and copy it to your clipboard.

**Step 2** Open a word processor, paste in the data and save the file as a text file (extension ".txt"). In what follows, we'll call the file "data.txt" .

JMP 4.0 Instructions

**Step 3** Under the JMP **File** menu, select "Preferences" and make sure that under "TextImport/Export">"ImportSettings", "Tab" and "Comma" are checked under "End of Field" and "<CR> + <LF>" is checked under "End of the Line".

**Step 4** Select "Open Data Table" from the Jump Starter.

**Step 5** In the dialog box that appears, select the directory where you put data.txt and select "data.txt" for the "File name:".

**Step 6** In the dialog box, select "TextImportFiles" for "Files of type:".

**Step 7** Click on **Open**.

JMP-IN 3.2.6 Instructions

**Step 3** Under the JMP-IN **File** menu, select "Import">"Text/Others".

**Step 4** In the dialog box that appears, select the directory where you put data.txt and select "data.txt" for the "File name:".

**Step 5** In the dialog box, select "TextFiles" for "Files of type:".

**Step 6** Open the "Options" dialog box and make sure that "Labels", "Tab", "Comma" "<CR>", "<LF>" and "<CR> + <LF>" are all checked.

**Step 7** Click on **Open**.
