General Information:

- Always maintain at least ½ tank of gas
- Always buckle up and drive safe
- Maintain your vehicle(s) for seasonal change (Summer and Winter)
- Change your stored water and food supply every six months so it stays fresh

Contents:

- Bottled water*
- Nonperishable high energy foods*
Granola bars, raisins, peanut butter, nuts, candy
- Maps*
- Ice scraper and brush*
- Battery powered radio*
- Flashlight*
- Extra batteries*
- Blankets*
- Jumper cables*
- Road emergency flares*
- Extra clothing (hat, mittens, socks, boots)*
- Florescent distress flag or bright cloth*
- Tools needed to change/repair flat tire*
- Collapsible shovel*
- First Aid Kit*
- Mobile phone and charger*
- Bag of sand or kitty litter (for traction)*
- Tire chains (in areas with heavy snow)
- Tool kit (include pliers, wrench, screwdriver)
- Writing pad and pencils
- Pole (if you have no antenna)
- Non-electric can opener
- Candles and matches
- A can (to melt snow for water)
- Tow rope
- Compass
- Newspapers (insulation)
- Fire extinguisher (Standard Class ABC)
- Siphoning hose
- Strips of carpet (for traction)
- Rock salt
- First Aid manual
- Sanitation (toilet tissues)
- Pocket knife
- Sleeping bags
- Plastic bags (for sanitation)
- Cards, games, and puzzles
- Large empty can (emergency toilet)
- Extra quarts of oil
- Gallon of coolant
- Gallon of windshield wiper cleaner
- Extra fan belts
- Extra spark plugs
- De-icer to defrost locks
- Necessary medications
