³ Faculty are counted in department of primary rank.

⁴ FTE (full-time equivalent) is the portion of salary paid from departmental General University funds; the *Total* FTE is used in the SCH/FTE ratio in the last column.

⁵ Student credit hours are calculated by multiplying the course credit by the number of students enrolled in the course.

⁶ The SCH per FTE ratios for the colleges exclude SCHs with no associated instructor FTEs; the University ratio also excludes Veterinary Medicine.
