Department administered by Agriculture and Engineering: Agricultural and Biosystems Engineering.

Department administered by Agriculture and Family and Consumer Sciences: Food Science and Human Nutrition.

² FTE (full-time equivalent) is the portion of salary paid from departmental General University funds; the *Total* FTE is used in the SCH/FTE ratio.

³ SCH (student credit hours) are calculated by multiplying the course credit by the number of students enrolled in the course.

⁴ Faculty are counted in department of primary rank.

⁵ For undergraduates with more than one major, the degrees awarded and the majors are counted in each department administering the major.

They are counted only once in the All Colleges and University totals.

⁶ NASF (net assignable square feet) for departments administered by two colleges is counted in each college but only once in the All Colleges and University Totals.

⁷ The SCH per FTE ratios for the colleges exclude SCHs with no associated instructor FTEs; the University ratio also excludes Veterinary Medicine.
