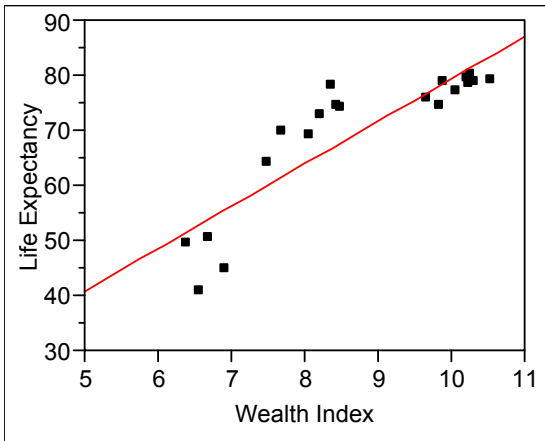


- Who?** Countries of the world.
